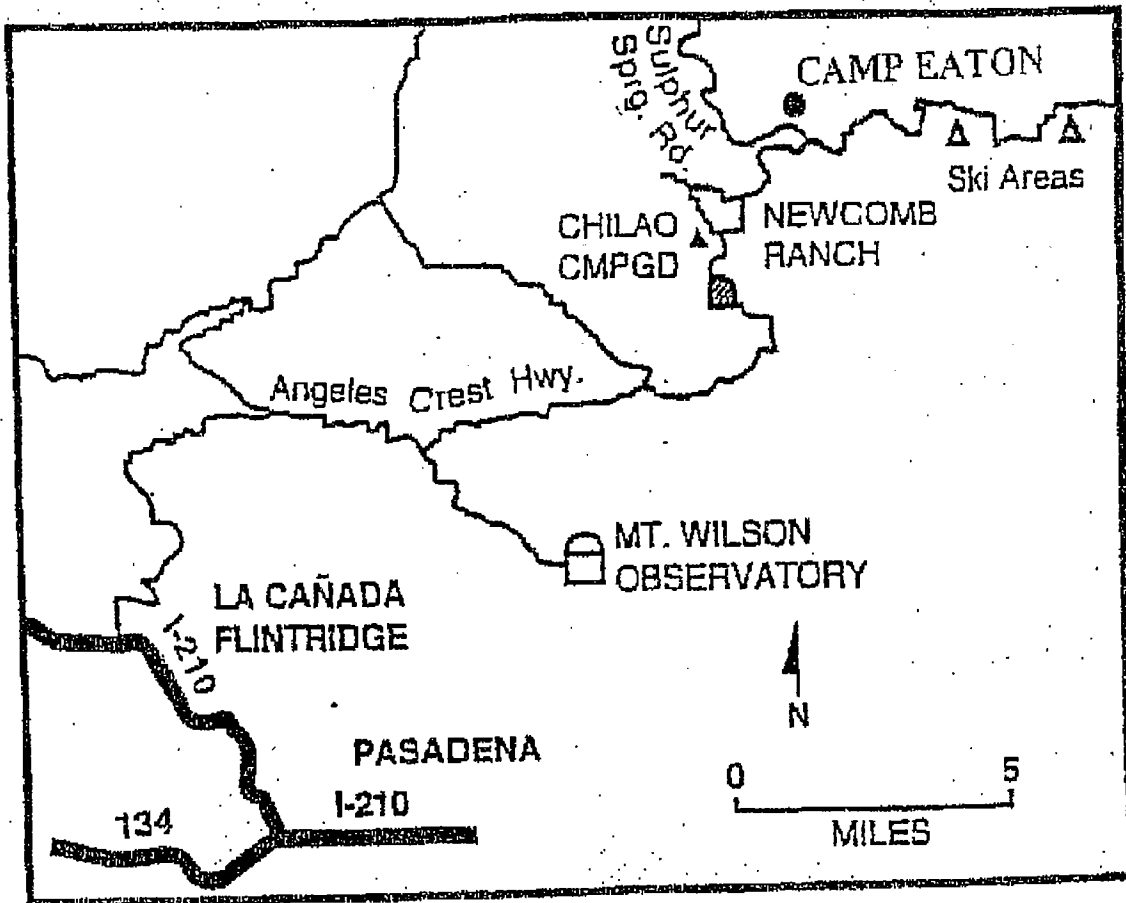

Directions to Camp Eaton

Take 210 to Highway 2 off-ramp (Angeles Crest Highway). Turn north, (towards the mountains) following Highway 2 approximately 30 miles. Turn left on Sulphur Springs Road. Continue ¼ mile to Camp Eaton sign. The drive in good weather will take approximately 40 – 45 minutes. Sulphur Springs road is 3 miles past the Chilao campgrounds.

It should be noted that during the winter season, conditions can be unpredictable. It is a good idea to 'be prepared'.
