From Pasadena: take 210 east through Glendora. Follow 210 as it turns south toward I-10, take the I-10 east. Go east on the I-10 fwy. for 8 miles and exit at Euclid Ave. Turn left onto Euclid Ave. Go north 1.8 miles and make a right on E. Stowell St. just north of 8th St. and below the railroad tracks. Go 2 blocks east, located on right (south) side of street.
