**JOB DESCRIPTIONS:**

**CAMPMASTER**

Be in charge of the camp and its activities for the week-end. Check-in camping groups and assign campsites. Contact group leaders prior to camp to verify needs, size of group, and review how to get to camp and operate the combination lock. Hold group orientation and activity sign-up meetings. Visit Camp grounds 2 times during the weekend. Get necessary equipment ready and check-out equipment. Collect fees for any damaged equipment. Clean and put away equipment. Make list of any equipment needing replacement. Be responsible for the cleanliness of the conference room and the campmaster quarters. Assist groups, where needed in activity programs and run, if necessary. Assist the Traskmaster in taking inventory of the trading post. Be responsible for picking up keys and locks and other items to open camp and returning them at the end of the weekend. Replace locks on gates as you leave camp. Meet with ranger to report on camping groups at end of weekend. Report to fire department on Friday evening the number of campers expected for weekend.
