### **Trip Objective:**

**Webelos:** Have fun! Also learn about Boy Scout camps and Boy Scout activities. Weather permitting, we should be able to do zip-line, mountain boards, archery, a hike, maybe BB guns, etc. The older scouts on the trip will participate in these activities with the younger scouts.

### **All Others:**

(You can learn how to use a compass.) A lunar eclipse starts on moonrise Saturday at 4:51 PM and ends at 8:21 PM. Bring your binoculars.
